

# ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN GENERAL STUDIES

The Associate of Arts degree in General Studies is designed for students who desire a broad educational foundation. This degree requires 60 credits from a combination of core courses in general education and biblical/theological studies, plus electives. Degree students who decide to continue their education can make the transition to a Bachelor of Arts degree program without a loss of credits. The Associate of Arts degree is administered by the General Education Department.
